-The meetings that Todd attended this month were focused on power and water issues.

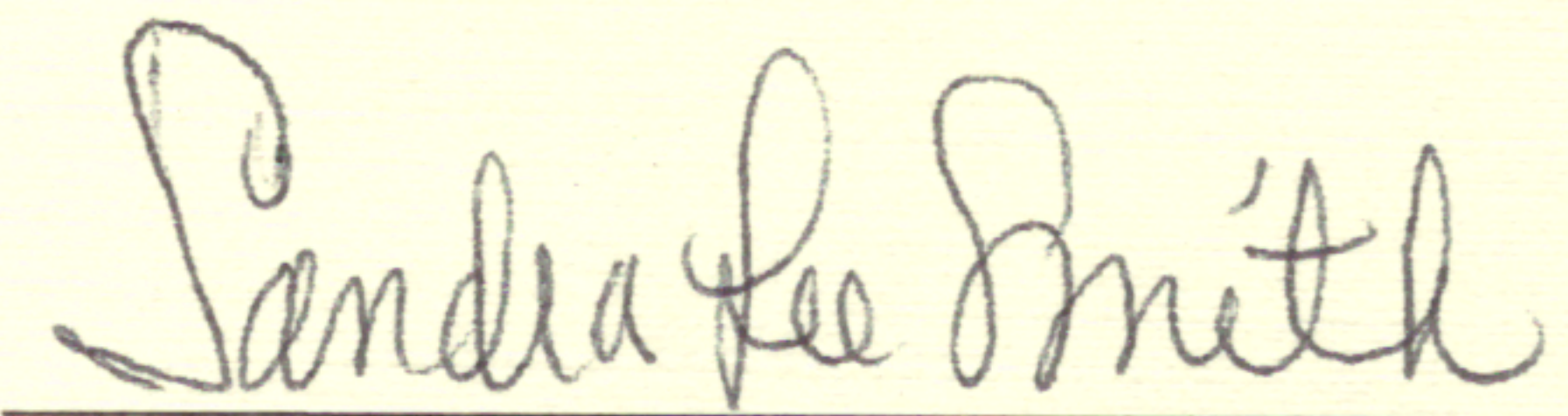
The Solar project is still on schedule to come online sometime next year. Because of low water levels at the dams and lakes, next year could be a challenging year for power.
