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MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN TAN IRRIGATION DISTRICT MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA August 4, 2026

A meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Tan Irrigation District, Maricopa County, Arizona, was called to order on August 4, 2026 at 6:02 P.M. by Ryan Landrum, President of the Board of Directors.

a. **Update on District Business and Projects:**

-Maricopa County Treasurer reports remain inaccurate. Todd had a Teams Meeting with their group for updates. They are still working on their programs, trying to fix their problems.

Vehicles – Shawn Badger provided Todd with information about an outside company's liquidation of used vehicles that might interest the District. The Board discussed this and other options for adding another vehicle to the fleet.

-Crown Castle – cell phone towers leases – Crown Castle is wishing to renew the lease that is located on our property. They provided three options for renewal and the Board agreed that the lease extension option would be the best choice.

- GIS Mapping – Our Engineering partner, George Cairo Engineering introduced Todd to a mapping system for the District through Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. (esri). Todd will have a meeting with the representative to learn more about the program and the benefits to the District.
